Return of the restored clock face: During blustery conditions in early April we saw the return of the newly restored clock face back to its rightful place on the tower by our expert restorer Symon Boy of Timsbury Clocks.

With Symon's help, we have successfully preserved another cherished piece of local history for generations to come. Keep an eye on our website and Facebook for project updates as they happen."





We are also looking for volunteers to help stewards on the day along the Colour Run route. We will meet on 5th June, at 7pm in the Square and we hope that all stewards will come along to walk the route and allocate stewarding points.

We will also be presenting this year's Carnival President Mrs Jenny Dinnis, Queen Miss Belle Trenaman and announcing the winning Prince and Princess. As the Colour Run falls so close to the 80th anniversary of the D-Day landings on June

6th we wanted to pay tribute, therefore the start will be covered with poppies and there will be an explosion of red powder. Remembrance (along with having fun and getting as colourful as possible) is very much the theme for the event.



There will be a Tree of Remembrance in the millennium garden, where you are invited to pause a while (don't forget, it is not a race!) write the names of loved ones on tags made of wildflower seed embedded paper and hang on the tree, we hope these tags will then eventually fall into the flower bed and start to grow on in their memory. We have dedicated the tree to a very brave young lady, Erin Chappel, who very sadly lost her fight with cancer, aged only 21. Erin had always wanted to take part in a Colour Run, and despite her poor health, Erin took part as best as she could. The image of Erin and her wonderful family having fun together made the whole event even more special. So please pay a visit to 'Erin's Tree of Remembrance'.

For the safety of the participants, we have closed the following roads: - Bridge St, High St, South St, Victoria Rd, Park Rd, Market St, Oakfield Rd between the hours of 15:30 and 18:00 – but we will of course open them earlier if possible. We shall be working a 'Rolling Road Closure' across the A386 and around the various roads of Moorview so there may be short delays for traffic, but we will keep things moving as safety dictates. Mr Robert Barkwell has very kindly, once again, allowed us to offer the use of his field to residents and visitors for parking on the day (at the owners risk). There are no parking restrictions, but you may choose to remove your vehicle so it doesn't get covered in coloured corn starch! But please note, the lane is part of the route, so will be difficult to access after 4pm. The Square will be shut earlier to allow for registrations from 1.30pm and stay closed until 11.59pm as the party will continue with musical entertainment from Ginja Ninja and amazing live bands. 1 member of the public attended the Annual Parish Meeting. This was followed by the Annual General Meeting.

- Election of Officers Mark Reddaway was re-elected as Mayor/Chair, Rachel Laycock was re-elected as Deputy.
- A full list of Councillors roles can be found on the HTC website.
- Councillor Vacancy 2 Residents presented to be co-opted for the Vacancy, unfortunately we only had one vacancy and Jake Barrs was duly co-opted.
- Councillor Kemp attended a meeting with Ruby Country Medical Practice, a summary report of which will be published on the HTC website and the HTC Facebook page.
- Councillors met with the WDBC Enforcement Officer and it is not possible to utilise the second entrance into school. HTC will contact DCC Highways Officer to explore other options i.e. a marked 'bus stop' at start and end of the school day.
- 20 is Plenty Campaign: Further larger signs will be purchased to keep this in the public mind.
- We still need volunteers to join a speed watch group. This will be advertised again on the HTC website and HTC Facebook page.
- Councillors have agreed to attend a training course to this end to boost the number of volunteers.
- We have now heard back from DCC about possible repairs to Millennium Corner. This is still being
 considered by DCC. Further updates will be posted as available.
- Hatherleigh Market: Unfortunately the approach to the Community Ownership Fund has been
 unsuccessful. The Friends of Hatherleigh Market are now pursuing a long term lease with





Work has started on the new steel bell frame at the bellhanger's workshop in Somerset. The eight headstocks (the cast iron fittings that support the bells) have been thoroughly cleaned and powder coated a bright signal red, courtesy of Right Angle of Hatherleigh. The lettering on the headstocks, which records details of the bell foundry, have been expertly picked out in black by Garry Bater - and look great.

Headstocks will shortly be returned to the bellhanger who will assemble the entire new frame, the restored bells and all fittings for testing, before dismantling and bringing them back to Hatherleigh.

The ringers will be out and about during the summer. You'll see us at the church fête in June, and during Hatherleigh Festival in July. At the Festival we will be running a rolling slide show of photos in the parish church, showing the different phases of the restoration project. Check out the Festival programme nearer the date for times when you can see the photos, and have a chat with the ringers.

There seems to be quite a lot of lovely rhubarb about so why not try these easy rhubarb muffins

230g fresh rhubarb
pinch of salt
2 tsp baking powder
125ml milk
2 large eggs well beaten
250g caster sugar plus some extra for the rhubarb prep
250g plain flour
110g butter or cooking margarine softened



First chop your rhubarb into quite small pieces, less than 1cm square, sprinkle with caster sugar and leave for about an hour; this will leach some of the moisture out of your rhubarb so the muffins aren't soggy. You won't need to waste the juice, you can mix it with tonic for a refreshing drink.

Cream the sugar and butter together and then add the eggs bit by bit..... do most of the beating at this stage, before you add the flour so the muffins have a nice soft texture. Add the flour and baking powder a bit at a time and beat just until smooth and then lastly gently fold in the rhubarb.

Put 12 muffin cases in a 12 section tray and fill.

Put in the middle of a pre-heated oven for 25-30 mins 180 degrees (until a bit golden)

As we are now getting our first strawberries you can make this recipe with chopped strawberries and later in the season you can use whole firm raspberries, blueberries or blackcurrants (you don't need to leach any of these fruits).


